**Note 2:** 51 women (3,6%) were unmatched.  
39 men (3,8%) were unmatched.

**Note 3:** Proportionally, men showed a greater interest in a career in Family Medicine and women showed less interest in a career in Family Medicine compared to the class of 2009. Proportionally, both men and women showed greater interest in a surgical career compared to 2009.
